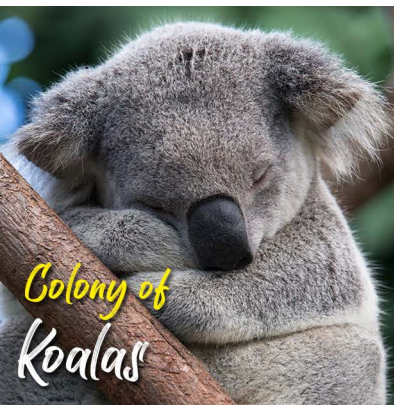
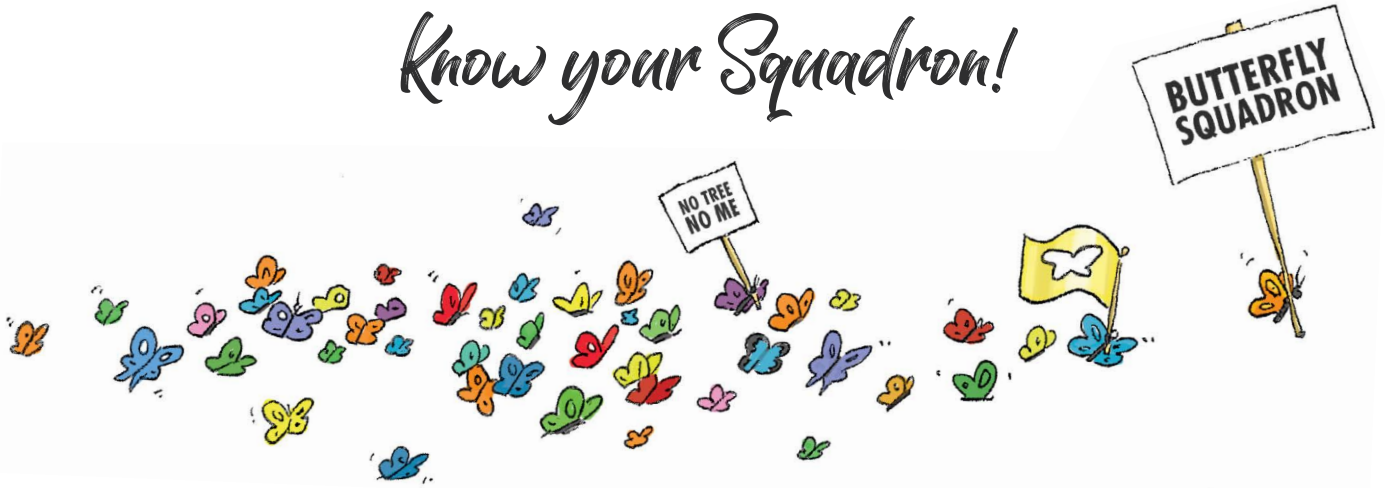
Respect Surroundings

Be as creative as you would like!



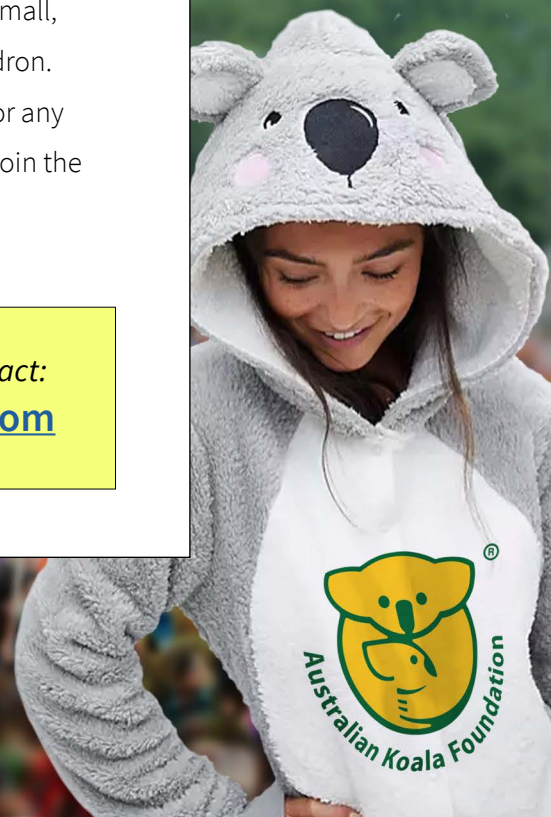
Schools
